1. Discussed upcoming Luncheons – “Hot Topics for Small Business”

2. ERCC 2018 Board Appointments
 - Amanda Sundquist, Esq. is now on the ERCC Board of Directors, but will remain on the GAC Council.
 - Elizabeth Mell is now on the ERCC Board of Directors, as well as the Marketing Committee, thus she will no longer be on the GAC. However, she will continue to prepare the Legislative Update to be distributed to the general membership, if we feed her the appropriate educational information for identified legislation.
 - Mark Reale is off the Board after 6 great years, but will remain on GAC.

3. Legislative Update
 - Pennsylvania overtime regulations, “Jobs That Pay” initiative being proposed by Governor Wolf – eligible top salary limit would more than double over 4 years.
 - Pennsylvania Redistricting – On January 22, 2018, “the Pennsylvania Supreme Court rocked the political world by ordering the state’s 18 congressional districts to be redrawn before the May 15 primary election.” – More to come...
 - SB 76 (Property Tax Independence Act) – tabled in 2017. Expected to come back again in 2018.
4. GAC Biennial Planning Review
 - A preliminary overview of goals for 2018 were discussed.
 - ERCC Board of Directors is conducting Strategic Planning
 - GAC will re-visit this topic at next meeting.
5. Meeting with Local Municipal Officials
